REGISTRATION INSTRUCTIONS & INFORMATION *(PLEASE KEEP THIS FORM FOR FUTURE REFERENCE.)*

PLEASE put your **child's name and program(s) attending** on all correspondence.

PRIOR TO REGISTERING, You **must** read the **Kroka Parent/Student Handbook**. This handbook, along with all other paperwork and forms mentioned below, can be found at our website, www.kroka.org, or call our office **(603) 835-9087** to get a copy by mail.

On a separate sheet of paper, have your child answer the student questions [on the other side of this paper] in his/her own words, preferably handwritten. If appropriate, feel free to have your child dictate the answers for someone else to write. Note that returning 3rd year students and students of day programs are exempt from this part of the application process. These questions allow us to make sure students have signed up for the appropriate program. It is important for students to answer these questions to the best of their ability. Don't forget to attach this to the registration form! Thank you.

Fill out the Registration Form completely. If you are applying for financial aid, complete the scholarship application and return it with your \$100 deposit, along with all the items listed above. **Mail the registration form**, your child's application answers, and your deposit check made out to Kroka, or your credit card information, for 50% of the total tuition prior to May 1st and full tuition plus \$25 late registration fee when registering after May 1st <or> a \$100 deposit and your completed scholarship application, to: **Kroka Expeditions Summer, 767 Forest Road, Marlow, NH 03456.**

BALANCE DUE – No later than May 1st, you should have obtained, completed, and mailed to us a Medical Form, Release Form, and Student Contract (for age 13 and up) and also sent the remaining amount of your tuition due.

If you are submitting your registration form AFTER May 1st, the **FULL TUITION** amount, including the \$25 late registration fee, is **DUE AT TIME OF REGISTRATION** along with your registration form. *** MARK YOUR CALENDAR! ANY REGISTRATION RECEIVED AFTER MAY 1ST. OR UNPAID TUITION BALANCE, OF THOSE PRE REGISTERED, RECEIVED AFTER MAY 1ST. WILL BE ASSESSED A \$25 LATE FEE.**

Acceptance packets will be mailed to you during the second week of May, assuming that all of your forms and tuition payments have been received. This packet will include a packing list and a more detailed description of your child's program(s). Certain programs will also require a small **extra materials fee** (see craft fee on registration form). This is for the cost of special materials needed for craft projects such as paddle, backpack, or moccasin making. If applicable to your program, you will see it on the registration form and should add it to your tuition.

AFFORDING KROKA: Kroka Expeditions is committed to allowing participation for everyone, regardless of ability to pay. We are able to sustain this as long as every family consciously pays as much as they can afford.

SLIDING SCALE FEE: Open to everyone. This is an honor-based form of financial aid.

SCHOLARSHIPS: Scholarship applications should be completed and mailed in with your registration form and **must** be accompanied by a \$100 deposit. Applications are available at our website, or by calling our office. Eligibility is based on income and circumstances. Your deposit will be refunded if you are not satisfied with the scholarship amount.

MEMORIAL SCHOLARSHIP FUNDS: Noah Simring and Julie Seiler Memorial Scholarship Funds: Two \$500 scholarships are available annually to qualified students. For more information and guidelines, please see our website or call the office for details.

PAYMENT PLANS: Payment plans can be arranged by calling our office. There is a \$50 fee for this service.

BARTER: For more information call the office (603) 835-9087. Limited barter opportunities are available based on your skills and Kroka's current needs.

PROVIDING OPPORTUNITIES FOR OTHERS: Kroka Expeditions was founded on the important principle of serving children and families regardless of income. In the summer of 2009, we contributed over \$65,500 in financial aid to families. In the spirit of supporting Kroka's mission we ask you to make a tax-deductible donation to our scholarship fund. There is space for this on the registration form. All the money in our scholarship fund offsets the tuition reductions on our sliding scale fee and provides additional financial aid that is needed by families beyond the sliding scale. Again, all donations to the scholarship fund are fully tax-deductible. Thank you!

CANCELLATION POLICY: Your deposit is non refundable (unless you are not satisfied with the scholarship amount). Any tuition payments made beyond the deposit will be refunded only when cancellation occurs prior to May 1st. In some cases (such as cancellation due to unexpected injury) tuition may be credited toward the following year.

REFUNDS: There are no refunds issued for students dismissed from the program due to illness or disciplinary reasons, or for students who choose to withdraw early from the program already in session. If a student must leave due to an injury incurred while on the program, a prorated portion of the tuition will be refunded.
