WINTER SEMESTER PACKING LIST

Bring, **Purchase**, or **Rent** the following items. As consumers we vote with our spending habits. Sometimes choices are limited due to budget constrictions, but when possible please reduce your footprint by choosing socially and environmentally responsible companies. (We prefer Patagonia and Wool Power, because they are two of the most responsible manufacturers.)

OPTIONS

- **BRING** (You need to acquire (*buy or borrow*) this item on your own. Need help or advice? Feel free to call us!)
- BRING OR PURCHASE FROM KROKA (you need to acquire this on your own OR you can purchase it from Kroka in advance)
- **BRING OR RENT FROM KROKA** (you need to acquire this on your own OR you can rent it from Kroka in advance)
- REQUIRED PURCHASE (no need for you to do anything; we will automatically add this item to your invoice)
- REQUIRED RENTAL (no need for you to do anything; we will automatically add this item to your invoice)
- **OPTIONAL** (this item is optional for you to bring if you want)

CLOTHING

SHORT SLEEVE COTTON SHIRT (3) BRING

Please be mindful of the graphics and logos you choose to represent!

__Long-sleeve wool thermal shirt (2) BRING OR PURCHASE FROM KROKA Wool. Kroka Store offers 200-weight wool by Woolpower, made in Sweden.

Sweater (2) BRING OR PURCHASE FROM KROKA
One for expedition; one for basecamp. Expedition: mid-weight fleece, lightweight
wool sweater, or wool shirt is appropriate. Kroka Store offers 400-weight wool by
Woolpower. This item is an all-time favorite of staff and students!
Insulated Jacket (1) BRING
Lightweight, warm, mountaineering-style down or synthetic with hood ,
and some butt covering. Examples: DAS parka or the Fitz Roy Down Hoody. Another
option is a layering system combining a <u>Down Sweater Hoody</u> with a <u>Nano Puff vest</u>
Shorts (1) BRING
Quick-dry, synthetic shorts. Example: <u>Patagonia Guidewater II Shorts</u>
Wool long underwear bottoms (2) BRING OR PURCHASE FROM KROKA
Wool. 1 mid-weight (200), and 1 light-weight (100). Kroka Store carries <u>200-weight</u>
wool by Woolpower.
Quick-dry pants (1) BRING
Lightweight, light-colored quick-dry pants for spring sun and bug protection.
Example: Patagonia Guidewater II Pants
Moule Dante (1) PDING
Work Pants (1) BRING Durable. Example: Patagonia Canvas Double Knee Pants
Durable. Example. <u>Latagoriia Carivas Double Kriee Lants</u>
Rain or shell pants (1) BRING
Must be waterproof, durable, and breathable. Example: Patagonia Torrentshell Pants.
Snow pants are not part of the winter equipment layering system, so no heavily
insulated shells.
Dress clothes (1) BRING
A nice clothing set for NYC events, presentations, contra dances, and other more
formal dress up occasions. Button-down shirt and dress pants, cardigans; female
students may substitute a skirt or dress for pants. A nice pair of dress shoes. No jeans
or work pants.
Bathing Suit (1) BRING
Lightweight long-sleeve sun-shirt (1) BRING
For the spring expedition on the Hudson River

Wool Socks (8) <i>BRING</i> Wool, various thicknesses. Example: <u>Darn Tough</u>
Sports Bra (2-3) BRING If applicable. Quick-dry wool or synthetic.
Sun hat (1) <i>BRING</i> If you sunburn easily, it should be wide-brimmed. Otherwise, a baseball cap will suffice. Kroka store carries US made baseball cap
Winter hat (1) <i>BRING</i> One mid-weight, warm hat.
Buff neck warmer (1) BRING Wool neck warmer; wool avoids odors. Example: Buff Merino Wool Neck warmer
Insulated leather work gloves (1) BRING Rigorous use during the semester will likely wear them out. Example: Kinko lined winter leather gloves
Light ski gloves (1) <i>BRING</i> Thin, lightweight wool/fleece/nylon glove for ski practice. Example: Swix focus glove
Mittens (1) BRING OR PURCHASE FROM KROKA Thick wool or wool blend mittens. Kroka Store offers 400-weight Woolpower mittens.
Ski skirt (1) BRING (If applicable) If you are female-bodied, a down or synthetic ski skirt is an effective solution for staying warm on coldest days
FOOTWEAR

__Insulated booties (1) BRING

Down or synthetic. Compressible with ankle cinch. US made examples include: <u>Feathered Friends</u>, <u>Western Mountaineering</u>

Running Shoes (1) BRING
Watersports sandals (1) BRING Must be secure on your feet to withstand the rigors of paddling expedition. Example: Chacos with a toe loop (Z2s with water soles). In addition, you may bring neoprene water shoes or socks for early spring paddling
Lightweight rubber boots (1) BRING For the spring expeditions wet weather and farm chores. Knee-high, flexible, lightweight, compact and packable (No neoprene Boots)
Insulated winter boots (1) BRING OR RENT FROM KROKA
GEAR
Sleeping bag (1) BRING Synthetic or down, rated 0-15 degrees F (depending on how warm you sleep). Mummy style bag that weighs less than 4 LBS with 700-800 fill.
Insulated sleeping pad (1) BRING OR PURCHASE FROM KROKA Lightweight, compact. Kroka Store carries US made Thermarest ProLite
Petzl Actik Core USB-rechargeable headlamp (1) BRING OR PURCHASE FROM KROKA
<u>This specific item</u> is required. Kroka Camp Store carries them. We have extra rechargeable batteries as part of our group gear, so our lights last for the duration of our expeditions.
Watch (1) BRING
Water bottle (1) <i>BRING</i> Wide-mouth, insulated 32-oz stainless steel water bottle. Example: <u>The Liquid Savvy</u> .
Sunglasses (1) BRING Please do not spend \$ on expensive sunglasses!
Ski Goggles (1) OPTIONAL

Match container (1) BRING
A screw-top pill bottle works well
Durable storage tub (1) <i>BRING</i> Durable, 18x32x18". Recommended: Rubbermaid Action Packer 24 gallon Model 1172 with locking lid
Cross-country ski racing gear BRING OR RENT FROM KROKA For pre-expedition practice; bring skate skis, boots and poles
lce Skates (1) BRING OR BORROW FROM KROKA For training in January. If you do not own a pair, find a pair to borrow.
Small day pack (1) <i>BRING</i> For having around campus to carry your journal, extra layer, etc.
85-liter Internal Frame Backpack (1) BRING OR RENT FROM KROKA For expeditions. Consider gender specific if buying your own. Example: Osprey Aether 85
Wetsuit (1) BRING OR RENT FROM KROKA
PERSONAL SUPPLIES
Toothbrush (2) BRING
Wooden handle preferred
Toothpaste powder or toothpaste (1) BRING All natural, please
Hairbrush or comb (1) BRING Compact/ lightweight
Bath towel (1) BRING Medium (not full size) bath towel
Glasses (2) BRING (If applicable) If you need them, please bring glasses only (not contacts). You will need a case and safety strap. Please bring a spare pair.

Menstrual supplies (5 months' worth) BRING (If applicable.) Environmentally friendly. Consider re-usable. Examples: menstrual underwear, Diva Cup, and reusable cloth pads.
Bandana (2) BRING OR PURCHASE FROM KROKA
For many uses. Kroka Store offers a variety, all US-made.
Mug (1) BRING
Your favorite tea mug for basecamp.
Instrument OPTIONAL
Let's play music! Bring whatever you play!
WRITING SUPPLIES
Pencils (5) BRING
Pens (5) BRING
3 felt-tip; 3 ball-point
Colored Pencils (1 set of no more than 12) BRING
Eraser (1) BRING
Drawing pencil quality
Letter writing supplies (20+) BRING
A minimum of 20 stamped envelopes
Watercolors OPTIONAL
Bring supplies if you paint!

REQUIRED PURCHASES (no need for you to do anything; we will automatically add this item to your invoice)

There are numerous **required purchases**, as stated in your financial acceptance form. These range from educational supplies and travel fees to craft supplies. Relevant to the packing list, the following items of clothing are **Required Purchases**, will be given to each student on arrival day, and are all embroidered with the Kroka logo. Please be sure you've filled out the Clothing Size form in your portal.

- Rain jacket
- Nordic ski pants
- Nordic training hat
- Wool short sleeved shirt

REQUIRED RENTALS (no need for you to do anything; we will automatically add this item to your invoice)

The following packages are **Required Rentals.** This gear is expedition specific, which is why Kroka insists on providing it. The rental cost covers the cost of the maintenance and repair of the equipment.

- 1. Arctic Warmth Package: Includes overbag (adds warmth to your personal sleeping bag), overboots, gaiters, winter anorak, and over mittens (similarly, adds warmth and waterproofing to mittens and gloves).
- 2. Expedition Ski Package: Includes backcountry skis, bindings, boots and poles
