- Purchase, gather and repair equipment, maps, craft supplies in collaboration with Gear
 & Facilities Managers, instructors & guest teachers
- Create menus and food curriculum that reflect Kroka's values, in collaboration with Food & Farm Managers and instructors

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❖ STAFF:

- Directly supervise and manage instructors at basecamp
- ➤ Hire & recruit expedition leaders and guest teachers, in collaboration with the Semester Leadership Team

❖ STUDENTS:

- Communicate with students before semester start, delivering feedback and support on fitness plans, packing lists and semester preparations
- > Hold the big picture of individual student health, wellbeing and development
- Communicate with students 2-4 weeks post-semester

CURRICULUM:

- > Support instructors with academic curriculum planning and instruction, in collaboration with the Semester Manager
- Maintain syllabi and curriculum documents
- Coordinate Big Job mentorship

- Oversee Emergency Response Plans, program clipboard, updated itineraries, and Kroka emergency communication
